SCHOOL ATTENDANCE AND THE LAW

THE EDUCATION ACT OF 1996 STATES THAT IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PARENTS AND GUARDIANS TO ENSURE THAT ALL CHILDREN BETWEEN THE AGES OF 5 AND 16 YEARS ATTEND SCHOOL ON A REGULAR BASIS AND ON TIME. AS A SCHOOL THAT CATERES FOR PUPILS AGED 3-19YRS, WE APPLY THIS RULE TO ALL OF OUR PUPILS.
